

## 2026 SPECIAL MEETING


A special meeting of the Duryea Borough Council was held at 315 Main Street, Duryea on February 18, 2026, at 5:30 p.m. with Council President, Stephanie Shupp presiding. After a pledge to the flag, a roll call was taken: (6) council members present, Hoover absent; Mayor Trina Moss was in attendance. With a quorum present, the meeting continued.

A short discussion was held regarding the only agenda item, a resolution to accept the transfer of a liquor license from Exeter Borough, Luzerne County, Pennsylvania. Gino Marriggi questioned the next steps if the transfer is not accepted by the borough; Solicitor Armezzani stated that the property owners could then go to the court of common pleas, where the borough will need to supply reasons for denial; Mayor Moss had the Hanover PD contacted to see if there were issues with the other store this company owns, with no issues being reported; Stephanie Shupp noted that, even with approval from the borough, ultimately the owners will also need to meet requirements through the PA Liquor Control Board and Luzerne County Zoning.

Motion by McGlynn, seconded by Gromelski to approve Resolution 2026-3 to approve the transfer of a liquor license, owned by Duryea Convenient & Beer LLC, from Exeter, Pennsylvania to Duryea, Pennsylvania. Roll call (6) yes.

No public comment.

With no further business to discuss, council entertained a motion to adjourn. First by Marriggi, second by McGlynn. The meeting ended at 5:37 p.m.
