

2025 SPECIAL MEETING

A special meeting of the Duryea Borough Council was held at 315 Main Street, Duryea on June 24, 2025, at 6:06 p.m. with Council President, Stephanie Shupp presiding. After a pledge to the flag, a roll call was taken: mayor and (4) council members present: Tonte, Brudzinski, Zinkavich, Shupp. With a quorum present, the meeting continued. Please be advised that this public meeting was advertised in the Times Leader legal section.


No public comment regarding the sole agenda item.

Motion by Tonte, second by Shupp to approve an amendment to Resolution 2025-3 to correct verbiage pertaining to DCED STMP Program. Roll call (4) yes.

A discussion was had regarding the multimodal grant program and the availability of other grants:

- DCED Multimodal
 - Focus on main street (Main/Foote)
 - Due July 21st having 2 years to use funding
 - Pedestrian and transit focused
 - Possibly have PPL change lighting on poles
 - Bus stop huts
 - Request cost estimates on all roads
 - All Keystone grants prioritize Main Street programs
- Yuhas building options
 - Possibly transfer to the Land Bank who could request RFPs to create specs for the property
 - Apply for grants for demolition or development
- Façade Program – due in August; \$50k vs and LSA at \$200
- Small Water and Sewer to separate storm and sewer
- Neighborhood Assistance - tax credit program to donors
- Beautiful Blocks grant – Neighbor Works to run the program awarded to certain blocks in the municipality

With no further business to discuss, council entertained a motion to adjourn. First by Zinkavich, second by Tonte. Meeting ended at 7:12 p.m.
