

DURYEA BOROUGH WORK SESSION – March 2025

Duryea Borough Council met for a work session on March 4, 2025, at 6:17 pm regarding items for an agenda for the March monthly council meeting. Council members present: Brudzinski, Tonte, McGlynn, Marriggi, Zinkavich, Shupp; Mayor Bauman was in attendance. This public meeting was advertised in the Times Leader.

OLD BUSINESS

- Main Street address (north vs south) - Luzerne County 911 stated that the best way to correct the duplicate addresses on Main Street would be to renumber the entire Main Street.
- Liquid Fuels funds – roads in need of paving were discussed.
- Rental Registration Ordinance – Solicitor Watt stated that the ordinance almost complete; inspection portion could be added at a later date.
- LSA suggestions to be brought to the next meeting.
- Main Street sidewalk LSA/HOP authorization – McGlynn questioned if the Yuhas property has a highway occupancy permit on it; questioned the width of the sidewalks, concerned about available parking and cars parking on sidewalks.
- STMP program match was discussed; Brudzinski has a call scheduled with Ted from Hailstone Economics.

NEW BUSINESS

- Formation of a Levee Committee and Bridge Committee was discussed to continue working with the Flood Protection Authority on the 2025 BRIC grant.
- 268 Main Street – meeting will be set to discuss the plans for the building.
- Healey Playground – next steps will include the rubber surface under the handicap ride, Danny to get a quote on hydro-seed, and contact Cedar Forest about the covers around the bolts on the pavilion.
- Benefit Cost Analysis cost was discussed for the 2025 BRIC grant; MyGlynn requested we contact Ted Ritsick to see what the cost actually covers and when is the resolution needed.

Meeting adjourned at 7:15 pm, with the next monthly council meeting to be held on February 11th at 6:30 pm.
