

2021 SPECIAL MEETING

A special meeting of the Duryea Borough Council was held at 315 Main Street on September 30, 2021, at 7:08 p.m. with Council President Jeffrey Bauman, presiding.

After a pledge to the flag, a roll call was taken: (6) council members present; McGlynn absent. Mayor Moss was in attendance. With a quorum present, the meeting continued.

Council met in executive session this evening to discuss personnel matters of the Street Department.

Motion by Ameika, second by Rowlands to accept the resignation of Street Supervisor, Gino Marriggi. Roll call (6) yes.

Motion by Ameika, second by Brudzinski to appoint Robert Webb as interim supervisor for the Street Department until such time that a permanent supervisor has been appointed. Starting salary \$ 21.51 per hour. Roll Call (6) yes.

Motion by Rowlands, second by Tonte to authorize an advertisement for a full-time street Department Supervisor, starting salary \$22.00 per hour. Roll Call (6) yes.


Motion by Rowlands, second by Bauman to ratify the approval of Resolution 2021-3 regarding a Local share Account Grant for a building addition project for Excelsior Hose Company, in the amount of \$250,000. Roll call (6) yes.

Motion by Brudzinski, second by Ameika to ratify the approval of Resolution 2021-4 regarding a Local Share Account Grant for an upgrade at Healey Playground, in the amount of \$260,611.26. Roll Call (6) yes.

Motion by Tonte, second by Ameika to ratify the approval of Resolution 2021-5 regarding a Local Share Account Grant for paving of Railroad Street (Phoenix St. to New St.) and Stephenson Street (Main St. to bridge) in the amount of \$375,573. Roll Call (6) yes.

Motion by Ameika, second by Gromelski to enter into an agreement between Duryea Borough and the North East Pennsylvania Land Bank and the Redevelopment Authority of the City of Pittston to implement a Local Share Account Grant that was recently approved in the amount of \$250,000, with Duryea Borough as the sponsor. Roll call (6) yes.

With no further business to transact, the chair entertained a motion to adjourn. First by Rowlands, second by Ameika to adjourn at 7:12 P.M.
